



## Cocktail Recipes

In a Printer-Friendly Format (ie no pics or backgrounds)

### Desirée 'On the Rocks'

*Our Straight Vodka really is that smooth....even people who would never think of drinking vodka on the rocks find they like it....*

Pour vodka over ice in a rocks glass.  
Add a squeeze of lemon, lime or orange depending on your taste or mood.  
Sip & Enjoy!

### Desirée Cape Cod

*Allegedly named for the place where it first became popular, this is the forerunner of the Cosmo.....*

In a rocks glass with ice, combine:  
1 part Desirée Straight vodka  
1 part cranberry juice  
1 lime squeeze  
Stir; garnish with lime wedge or wheel.

### Desirée Mochatini

*Probably the most popular drink we've ever served. If you enjoy the great coffee drinks at your local coffeehouse, you simply must try this.*

In a shaker with ice, combine:  
2 parts Desirée Brownie Batter flavored vodka  
2 parts coffee liqueur  
1 part half & half  
Shake well. Strain into martini glass.  
Optional: garnish with a piece of dark chocolate or chocolate shavings.

### Desirée Straight & \_\_\_\_\_

*When you just want something simple to sip on, how do you usually drink your vodka? Desirée is such a smooth, soft vodka that it works with lots of mixers....*

In a rocks glass, combine over ice:  
1 part Desirée Straight Vodka  
1 part mixer  
Stir. Garnish with fruit.  
*Try whatever mixer suits your fancy: club soda, tonic, diet tonic, 7-Up, etc. Desirée makes a uniquely pleasant drink with any of them.*

### Desirée Cosmo

*Made wildly famous by the hit show Sex & The City, the Cosmopolitan has become a cocktail classic. We created Desirée Straight vodka with this drink in mind, and it makes quite possibly the best-tasting Cosmo you've ever had.*

In a shaker with ice, combine:  
2 parts Desirée Straight vodka  
1 part cranberry juice  
1 part orange liqueur  
½ part lime juice  
Shake and strain into a chilled martini glass.  
Garnish with a lemon or orange twist.

### Desirée Crème Brulee Martini

*If Crème Brulee is on the menu, you must have it.*

In a shaker with ice, combine:  
3 part Desirée Crème Brulee flavored vodka  
1 part half & half  
Shake well. Strain into martini glass.  
Optional: garnish with a strawberry slice.



### **Desirée Velvet Cola**

*Not a combination most people think of right away, but soooo good.*

In a rock glass with ice, combine:

1 part Desirée Red Velvet Cake flavored vodka

2 parts regular or diet cola

Stir. Garnish with a maraschino cherry.

### **Desirée Velvet Bomb**

*Want to turn up the volume, but without the horrible taste of the classic J-Bomb? Try this instead:*

In a shaker with ice, combine:

1 part Desirée Red Velvet Cake flavored vodka

1 part energy drink (we suggest Red Bull)

Stir. Strain into shot glasses.

*Note: can also be enjoyed as a rocks drink – just pour the two ingredients over ice and enjoy!*

### **Desirée Cat in the Hat**

*This has a cult following in the Northeastern U.S.:*

In a blender, combine:

2 parts Desirée Red Velvet Cake flavored vodka

3 parts Ben & Jerry's Cherry Garcia ice cream

Blend on a low to medium speed until well-mixed to a milkshake-like consistency.

Pour into daiquiri or margarita glass.

Top with whipped cream, then chocolate chips and a maraschino cherry. Serve with both a straw and a spoon.

### **Desirée Peppermint Patty**

*Refreshing and delicious!*

In a shaker with ice, combine:

2 parts Desirée Brownie Batter flavored vodka

2 parts peppermint liqueur/schnapps

Shake well. Strain into martini glass.

Optional garnishes: cut a wedge out of a peppermint patty and hang the remaining wheel on the rim of the glass; or, float a sprig of fresh mint in the glass.

### **Desirée Red Velvet Cake Martini**

*A decadent tradition, born in the South and now treasured by all of America. Our martini tastes just like a big slice of Red Velvet Cake in a glass. But with less guilt.*

In a shaker with ice, combine:

3 parts Desirée Red Velvet Cake flavored vodka

1 part half & half

Shake well. Strain into martini glass.

Top with whipped cream and red sugar crystals.

*Note: Can also be served as a shot.*

### **Desirée Boston Cream Pie Martini**

*A great Boston Cream Pie is a chef's work of art. The same is true of this martini – the layers of flavors go on and on.....*

In a shaker with ice, combine:

2 parts Desirée Cake flavored vodka

2 parts Desirée Crème Brulee flavored vodka

1 part Desirée Brownie Batter flavored vodka

2 parts half & half

Shake well. Strain into martini glass.

Top with whipped cream; drizzle chocolate syrup over the top.

### **Desirée Banana Pudding Martini**

*A comfort-food classic dessert, now in a low-guilt martini!*

In a shaker with ice, combine:

2 parts Desirée Crème Brulee flavored vodka

2 parts banana liqueur/schnapps

1 part amaretto

1 part half & half

2 shakes of powdered cinnamon

Shake well. Strain into martini glass.

Garnish with a freshly cut banana slice and a dusting of powdered cinnamon floating on top.



### **Desirée Cake Batter Martini**

*You say it's your Birthday? Then this is your drink. (It's also perfect for any type of celebration occasion.) There are lots of similarly-flavored vodkas out there now; Desirée was the first and in our humble opinion remains the best of them all. Its delicious, gourmet flavor profile tastes like no other and makes a fantastic martini....*

In a shaker with ice, combine:  
3 parts Desirée Cake flavored vodka  
1 part half & half

Shake well. Strain into martini glass.  
Top with whipped cream and sprinkles.  
*Note: Can also be served as a shot.*

### **Desirée Pineapple Upside Down Cake**

*This is a "WOW" drink...that's what everyone says when they taste it. And, it's not super-strong, so you can easily sip on these all afternoon or evening. In fact, just mix up a pitcher for your next get-together!*

In a shaker with ice, combine:  
1 part Desirée Cake flavored vodka  
1 part amaretto

3 parts pineapple juice  
Shake well. Strain into martini glass.

*Note: To make a party-sized batch, pour the same proportions into a pitcher, add a couple cups of ice, and stir.*

### **Desirée Tiramisu**

*A delicate, light dessert, in a glass!*

In a shaker with ice, combine:  
2 parts Desirée Cake flavored vodka  
2 parts coffee liqueur  
1 part half & half

Shake well. Strain into martini glass.  
Top with whipped cream and dark chocolate sprinkles.

### **Desirée Red Coffee**

*First made famous as a morning drink special in the French Quarter. This is similar to an Irish Coffee, just better.*

In a coffee mug, combine:  
2 parts hot coffee  
1 part Desirée Red Velvet Cake flavored vodka  
Sweeten to taste with sugar or other sweetener.  
Top with whipped cream.

### **Desirée Lemon Pound Cake**

*Who can resist? This has all the buttery, lemony goodness of the homemade classic, even the frosting!*

In a shaker, combine:  
3 parts Desirée Cake flavored vodka  
2 part limoncello  
1 part half & half  
Shake and strain into a martini glass.  
Optional: top with whipped cream, or garnish with a lemon wheel.

### **Desirée Sunshine**

*This is the perfect summer drink! Ultra-low-carb/sugar, and Ultra-high deliciousness!*

Make a pitcher of Crystal Light sugar-free lemonade.

In a glass of ice, combine:  
2 parts lemonade  
1 part Desirée Straight Vodka  
Squeeze two lemon wedges into the glass, then toss in the squeezed wedges themselves also.  
Stir and serve.

*Note: For a party, or just to pre-make a batch ahead of time, add the vodka directly to the pitcher in the same proportions, and use a whole lemon's worth of lemon wedges. Keep chilled in fridge.*



### **Desirée Red Russian**

*This is essentially a classic White Russian, except using Desirée Red Velvet Cake flavored vodka. Yum!*

In a rock glass with ice, combine:

2 parts Desirée Red Velvet Cake flavored vodka

1 part coffee liqueur

Stir gently to mix. Wait for the ice and liquid to stop swirling, then float 1 part half & half on top of the mixture. (Tip the glass and pour gently down the side to get the float.)

### **Desirée Fizzy Cake**

*Super-easy, super-yummy.*

In a rock glass with ice, combine:

1 part Desirée Cake flavored vodka

2 parts 7-Up

Mix, and garnish with lemon. Or a cherry. Or both.

### **Desirée Russian Cake**

*A variation on a White Russian, only better....*

In a rock glass with ice, combine:

2 parts Desirée Cake flavored vodka

1 part coffee liqueur

Stir gently to mix. Wait for the ice and liquid to stop swirling, then float 1 part half & half on top of the mixture. (Tip the glass and pour gently down the side to get the float.)
